

**Club Business:** The Club discussed the possible District Simplified Grant projects we might like to submit. George Gotcsik informed us that the one we

were looking doing for the Village new “park” can't be put together at this time. Our soon to be new member Fany Laughlin offered another project we could undertake that is to purchase the main curriculum for the Earn While You Learn program that is run by the Pregnancy Resource Center in Mt. Morris. This computer program would be used to help teen age girls ( and the fathers) who become unexpectedly pregnant to learn how to become a good parent to their new born child. It will cover through the pregnancy and the first two years of the child's life. The parents who are enrolled in this program can earn credits by attending appointments, being on time, going to their monthly Obstetrician appointments, participating in all classes along with completing the homework that is required. They can use the credits to purchase baby clothes, diapers, furniture, maternity clothes and other necessities which come up. This main curriculum (which will cost \$1,800) is only part of what is needed for this course. The Pregnancy Resource center will be purchasing 40 modules to

be used by their clients that will have a price tag of about \$5,450.00. Our Club agreed to see if we can get a District Simplified Grant to help us with this project and that we will also submit one for a Scholarship grant to be used at Genesee Community College. Bill Redden volunteered to put the grant requests together and get them submitted before the deadline of Monday April 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Program:** Pat Brady introduced Gail Cochrane, the
