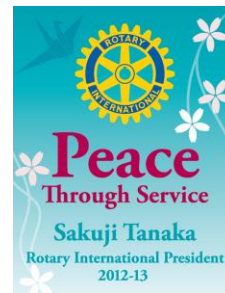

The members told her they would discuss it and get back to her.
