Program: We had two programs tonight. First we welcomed Gov. Elect Alexandria Martinez Adams to our meeting. Gov. Elect Alexandria is staying with President Wanda and Jerry Tubbs on her way to San Diego for her RI



Training. GE Alexandria told us she is a member of the Santiago Club in the Dominican Republic which is in District 4060. Her District has 65 clubs and about 1,425 members and covers the whole country. Her District (and club) has worked on water and sanitation projects and is starting a \$2 million clean water project. Her husband Charles (is resting at the Tubbs home tonight), who also is a Rotarian, has been presented with Rotary's Service Above Self Award. GE Alexandria told us her first contact with Rotary was as a Rotaract at the University. During her year as Club President she started a hand washing project that will now become a national project though out the Dominican Republic.

Our second program tonight was presented by Chris Luft (her husband Carl is the Mayor of Lima) who talked to us about her work in the Dominican Republic. Chris and Carl starting traveling to Peurta Plata in 1992 with a small group. In 1993 when they visited they



returned they brought along clothes to give to the children of this community. They have been going back to Peurta Plata ever since and have become more involved in helping the children of this community. They have built a small school there and are at present trying to put an addition on to it. They are still trying to raise an additional \$11,000 to do this. They are at present working with the Tampa Bay Rays to see if they can set up a joint fundraising program with them. Chris told us that she is looking for any way to help continue to raise funds for the school and other projects within Peurto Plata and welcomes any donations.

Gov. Elect Alexandria presented to President Wanda a flag from her District and we presented her one of our Club flags to take back home with her.
