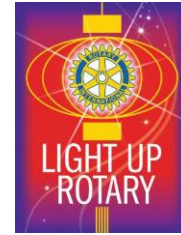

Charlie was a former Rotarian in the Saratoga area before he moved here to Lima. We welcome Charlie and look forward to getting to know him better.

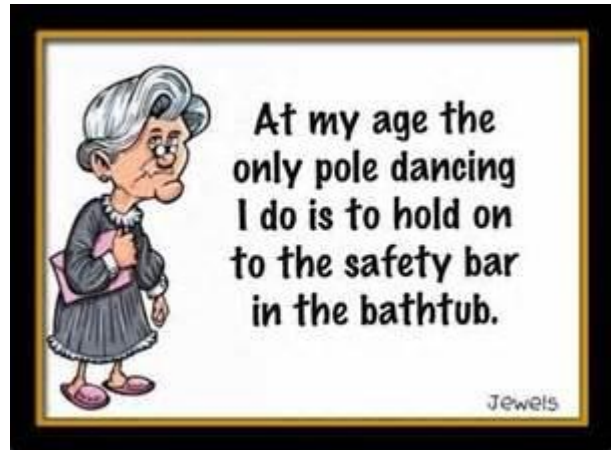
