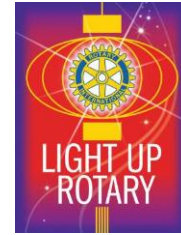

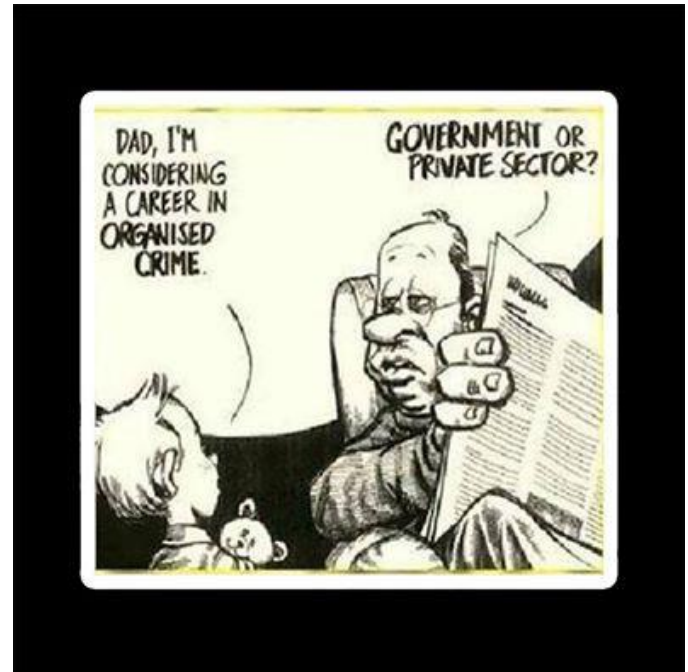
only 7 hours a day. Tony said unless the U.S. Congress changes the law local Post Office can't be closed unless due to special circumstances. He did tell us that some of the smaller Post Offices have had their hours cut to 2 or 4 hours to save money. We were advised that the number of packages going through our Post Office has risen 15% this year. A question was asked as what can we do to make sure we continue to have a local post office and Tony told us to encourage all residents of our community to buy stamps and send packages and mail through the local Post Office. We were also told that the U.S. Post Office has "hooked up" with Fed EX and UPS to deliver packages for them. Tony told us that in some small communities that have lost their Post Office local business has open up a mini office in their location. He also mentioned that the U.S. Post Office is working with Staples and possibly Office Max to become mini Post Offices.
